

## PRICE MOVEMENT

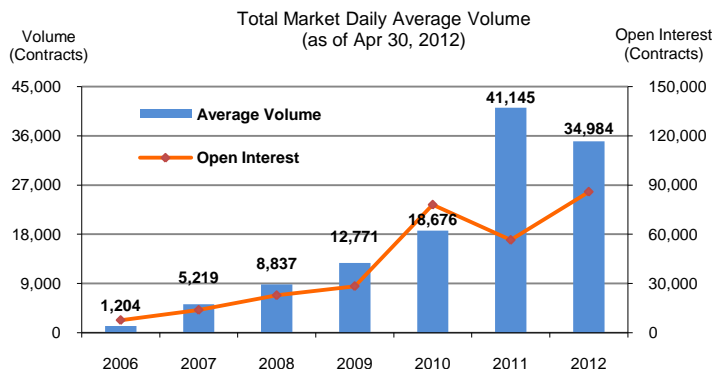
SET50 Index moved up 20.91 points, or about 2.48% from the previous month closing at 863.82 points. The positive sentiment mainly came from the better than expected Q1 earning reports. The SET Index manage to hit a 16 year high on April 30<sup>th</sup> at 1,228.49 points.

For precious metals, LBMA Gold A.M. and Silver fixing for the end of April were at \$1,662.50 and \$31.20, respectively. The Brent Index was at 119.76.

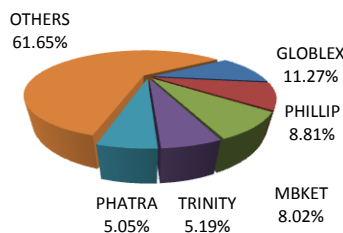

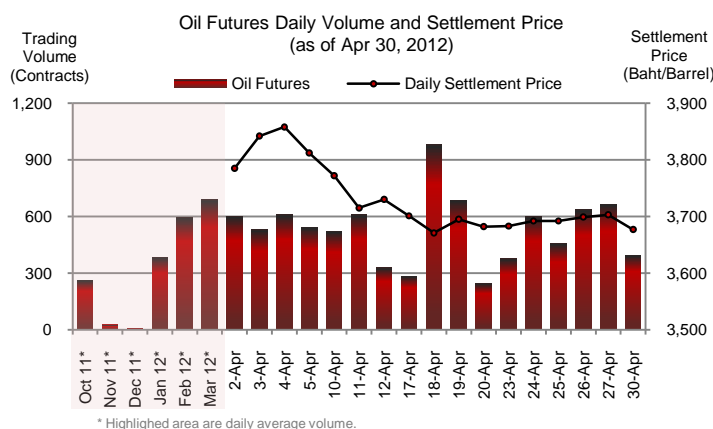
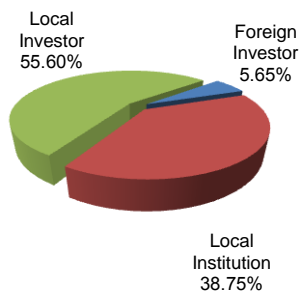
